Overseas Accreditation

- Some accreditation of other countries university programmes
- Some accreditation of UK university franchised programmes
- Same process as UK accreditation –must visit

Recognition of Overseas Qualifications

- Recognise overseas qualifications which have been accredited by partner organisations
- Partnership entered into on satisfaction of two requirements:
 - partner has robust accreditation
 - qualifications are equivalent to UK

regulating the engineering profession



Recognition of Overseas Qualifications

- Automatically accept programmes accredited under International Engineering Alliance agreements (Washington Accord etc)
- Automatically accept qualifications on the FEANI Index
- Automatically accept EUR-ACE labelled degrees

EUR - ACE

- Not European Accreditation but European Recognition of National Accreditation

EUR-ACE

- ENAEE has agreed outcome statements (graduate attributes) for First and Second Cycle engineering degrees
 - ENAEE has agreed standards for accreditation procedures
- ENAEE has reviewed member accreditation agencies eg Engineering Council
- Successful national agencies are licensed to award EUR-ACE labels to accredited qualifications
